Children's Warden

The volunteer wardens work alongside the Indian wardens and look after the children's well-being in general. It involves helping the children to get ready in the morning, organising activities during their free time, helping them with their studies, being there when they go to sleep, etc. It is also important to be attentive to any changes in the children's' behaviour, identify the reasons and try to improve their condition by giving them care, love and attention; to be involved in the followup of children who are facing some specific challenges, whether at academic or psychological levels (social approach). The wardens have to ensure that the children having health problems are referred to the head of healthcare.



It is a demanding task with a different timetable from the other volunteers, but it is also an exciting and rewarding task as it allows a privileged relationship with the children. This task is perfect for people who like to spend time with children!



Tasks

- * Entertaining and taking care of the children during their free time,
- * Supervising the personal hygiene of each child,
- * Ensuring the children having health problems are referred to the head of healthcare,
- * Making sure that the children respect the school's schedule,
- * Making sure they understand the importance of punctuality and assiduity,
- * Observing and remaining aware of any changes of behavior from the children, identifying the reasons of the change and trying to improve their situation by giving them attention and affection,
- * Participating in the care of children facing special challenges.

Competences and qualities

- * Experience with children and in animation is required,
- * Studies in social work, psychology or teaching is preferable,
- * Interest in the growth and well-being of children,
- ✤ Listening skills,
- * Organizational capacities,
- * Being responsible, comprehensive and able to impose authority,
- * Creativity,
- * Sense of initiative,
- * Balanced personality,
- * To like sport is an advantage.
