CHICAGO, Dec. 10.—Prof. C. W. Hough of the Fort Dearborn Observatory, Northwestern University, has discovered that Tau Tauri is a double star. The companion star is of the ninth magnitude and was seen while Prof. Hough was observing an occultation of the moon.
