Any sons JOHN FRANCIS or WILLIAM ALFRED D. may have had will be the heirs to JOHANN BAPTISTE II, otherwise the next heir in line will be FRANCIS BOULTWOOD's elder son

The Breidenbachs have been traced back in Germany to the Middle Ages, but the owners of the research won't allow it to be published
 Franz Heinrich/Francis Henry Breidenbach was born possibly in Cologne, Germany, immigrated to the UK, married a Court Perfumer, William Page's daughter, Emily Ann Page (about 1817-1894), took over his perfumery business, which was established during the reign of King George III, and changed the name from PAGE to BREIDENBACH in 1836 – he was naturalized in 1847 - his children and grandchildren were given the name of Johann Maria Farina within their names after the famous Eau de Cologne manufacturer (1682-1754) – the perfume business was sold in the 1930's because, after Reginald Blackwell's death, there was no one to carry on the business
 Most of the family changed their surname from Breidenbach (pronounced "Brydenbach" in German) to Bryden owing to anti-German sentiment in the UK during WW1
