Description of our special tour:

1ST DAY:

Lunch and free time.

In the afternoon you'll have the possibility to take a walk among the old distinguished palaces, antiquity and restoration shops lying in the "Oltrarno", that is to say, on the other side of Arno nearby Borgo Santo Spirito. In this side of Florence, less known but worthy, we mustn't absolutely forget to see the Brancacci Chapel where we can admire the celebrated frescos of both painters, Masaccio and Masolino.

5TH DAY

Between spirituality and crafts Visit to the Charthusian monastery of Galluzzo. Free time and lunch. In the afternoon visit of Impruneta, the village which is celebrated for its "terra cotta".
